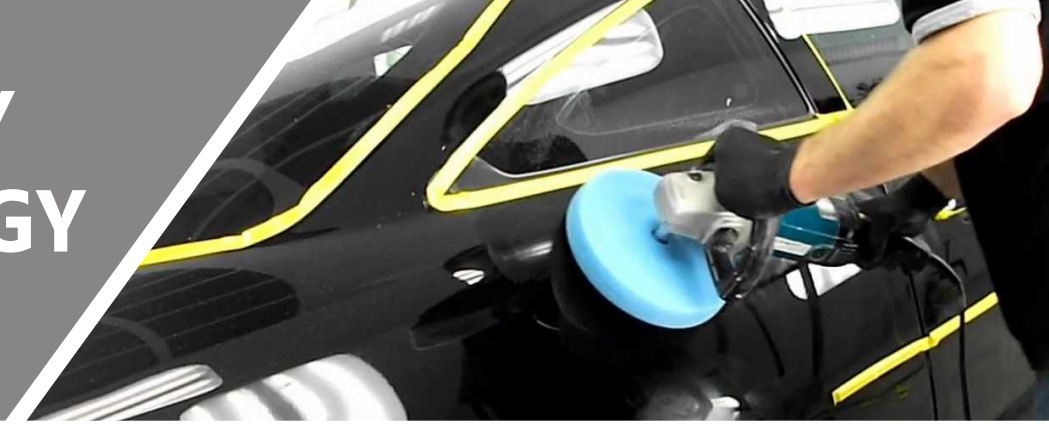


AUTO BODY TECHNOLOGY
