### CERTIFICATIONS FOR QUALIFYING STUDENTS

### COSMETOLOGY CAREERS OUTLOOK

- Beginning annual median salary of \$26,270 for Barbers, Hairstylists, and Cosmetologists; 8% expected job growth through the year 2028
- A cosmetologist's ability to bring in and maintain regular clients is another factor in determining potential earnings
- Post Secondary Education: Additional learning to become a Skincare Specialist or esthetician offers higher earning potential, \$34,090 and 11% expected job growth
