Position: Construction Technology Instructor for the 2022-2023 School Year at Ashland County-West Holmes Career Center

Qualifications: The successful candidate shall demonstrate strong organizational, communication, human relations, instructional, classroom management, team and public relations/community skills. Applicants should have a sincere interest in and a commitment to work with students, parents, staff, businesses, community organizations and associate district schools. The Construction Technology Instructor should possess a Building Maintenance or Carpentry Certificate or be able to be licensed by the Ohio Department of Education. Previous teaching experience is preferred in Building Trades including carpentry, plumbing, electrical and/or masonry.

Certification/Licensure: Applicants must hold an Ohio Standard Career-Technical Trade and Industrial Job Construction-Design Building, Training Building Maintenance or Carpentry Certificate/License; **OR** (the following options must be approved on a VE-36 Qualification Evaluation Form by the district or on a VE-37 Teacher Eligibility and Education Verification Form), have a high school diploma or GED and five years of approved work experience (10,000 hours with 6,000 hours completed within the last five years) in the Construction Technology or a related field; **OR** have an Associate Degree in Construction Technology and three years of approved work experience (6,000 hours completed within the last five years) in Construction Technology or a related field; **OR** Baccalaureate Degree not in Construction Technology or Education and five years of approved work experience (10,000 hours with 6,000 hours completed within the last five years); **OR** Baccalaureate Degree in Education not in Construction Technology and five years of approved work experience (10,000 hours with 6,000 hours completed within the last five years); **OR** Baccalaureate Degree in Construction Technology and two years of approved work experience (4,000 hours completed within the last five years). Applicants from industry will be required to complete state university/college teacher preparation course work. (A pre-employment three or four-week summer class at a selected state university/college is required if the applicant is not certified/licensed as a teacher.) Passage of a basic skills test (PRAXIS I) is recommended prior to consideration for employment if the applicant is not certified/licensed.

Duties: The Construction Technology teacher will teach junior and/or senior laboratory and related instruction in Construction Technology at Ashland County-West Holmes Career Center. The instructor will work closely with the immediate supervisor, advisory committee and academic teachers to coordinate instruction and to prepare students for successful completion of the Construction Technology program. The instructor should be able to teach and manage labs in the Construction Technology program.

Contract: 2022-2023 Contract – 183 prorated to start date contracted days. Teacher will follow the Career Center schedule, contract to begin when hired.

Salary: Appropriate placement on 2022-2023 teachers' salary schedule based on certification/ licensure, education/degree and experience.
