The Job Training Coordination program requires special recommendation from the student's school counselor. This program assists students in understanding their individual potential while helping match their abilities and goals through training for employment options.

ACADEMICS

Students in this program will take their academic classes with a highly qualified Intervention Specialist. Our classes are designed to enable students to be successful academically.

Students will complete the following courses:

- (2) English
- (2) Mathematics
- (1) Science
- (1) Government/Economics

Includes a focus to learn employability skills over the course of the two-year program.

EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS

Students learn basic work skills, such as following written and spoken directions, staying on task, work with adequate speed and quality, meeting deadlines, being on time and staying on schedule.

Soft-skills are also an emphasis of the program, including appropriate communication with co-workers, supervisors and other employees.
