Guidelines to be used in determining the annual scholarship amount, winner and presentation of the Dave Moore Memorial Fund:

- 1. Recipients must be a two-year student in an automotive related program, but he or she does not have to be in the senior graduating class.
- 2. The recipient should show leadership through responsibility in his or her vocational program, and must have the interest and enthusiasm to promote the automotive technology field. The student must be deserving shown through in-school citizenship and peer consideration.
- 3. Buckeye Speedway will determine who will present the award.
- 4. The instructor of the Automotive Technology program will pick three students from the Automotive Technology class and make recommendations to the Buckeye Speedway. Buckeye Speedway has the option to interview and make the final choice.
- 5. A plaque donated by Buckeye Speedway will be engraved yearly with the student's name, program and year awarded.
- 6. The award must be used for schooling or tools in the trade area. Tools must be purchased by the student and receipts turned in to the program instructor who will turn them into the Foundation, then a check will be made out to the student.
- 7. Buckeye Speedway will determine the amount and number of awards per year.

The Automotive Technology instructor will be the person in charge of collection of the Scholarship applications and the person to whom the application is submitted for consideration.
